

Message from our Founder Mr. Mohan Lal Grero



Once there was a father who had a family of sons. They were always quarreling among themselves. When he failed to solve their fights with his advice, he decided to give them a practical illustration of the evils of disunion; and for this purpose he one day told them to bring him a bundle of sticks. When they had done so, he placed the bundle into the hands of each of them in succession, and ordered them to break it in pieces. They tried with all their strength, but were not able to do it.

Next, he opened the bundle, took the sticks separately, one by one, and again put them into his sons hands, and asked them to break it, and they could do so very easily. MESSAGE FROM OUR COORDINATING PRINCIPAL MRS.KUMARI GRERO

Early Learning Goals for the Foundation Stage

The activities described in this book will help your child to work towards the following Early Learning Goals (ELGs) and Stepping Stones.

Language for communication

- * Listen with enjoyment and respond to stories, rhymes and poems and make up your own stories, rhymes and poems.
- * Extend vocabulary.
- * Use vocabulary and forms of speech that are increasingly influenced by the experience of books.
- * Explore the meaning and sound of new words.

Language for thinking

- * Use language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences.
- * Use talk to organise, sequence and clarify thinking, ideas, feelings and events.

Linking sounds and letters

- * Continue a rhyming string.
- * Hear and say initial and final sounds in words, and short vowel sounds within words.
- * Link sounds to letters, naming and sounding the letters of the alphabet.

Reading

- * Explore and experiment with sounds, words and texts.
- * Re-tell narratives in the correct sequence, drawing on language patterns of stories.
- * Read a range of familiar and common words and simple sentences independently.
- * Know that print carries meaning and, in English, is read from left to right and top to bottom.
- * Show an understanding of the elements of stories such as main character, sequence of events and openings.



PARENTAL EXPECTATIONS AND CHILDHOOD PERFORMANCE

The one childhood your child has should be one which they can joyously recall, and celebrate through life. Did you have one such? Yes, or no, all parents must make dedicated efforts to give this lifetime gift to their children. They need happy experiences, love, appreciation and attention to discover the world successfully, to grow into good citizens.

A child is not a 'small adult'. Children cannot cope with constant pressure to perform at the level of adult expectations as the skills, abilities and knowledge of Primary School children are not varied, or expansive. Obtaining one hundred percent marks at a test is an impossible task for the average child. If your children did not score as many marks as you did in school, or as you wished, motivate them with love and affection, not by repeatedly asking them to 'do better'. It is not a concept children in Primary Grades understand.

Parents must become a wholesome part of their children's lives: motivate them, work with them, play with them, admire their achievements (remember how you clapped and encouraged when the child took the first few steps without help?), hold their hand, walk with them, let them know you are there. Fear, threat, dejection, rejection, frustration, compulsion, absence of love and consideration scar children. Help your child learn better by 'not pushing' them. Your duty and responsibility is to endow them with a joyous, memorable childhood. Try. You can.
