Pichai studied metallurgical engineering at the Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur. His success there won him a scholarship to Stanford.

And today Sundar Pichai is the CEO of Google. In his home country, Pichai is seen as something of a hero. Throughout his spectacular rise, he remained incredibly humble. When questioned about his success he replied, "It is always good to work with people who make you feel insecure about yourself".

Dear children, what can we learn from this statement? We must learn to have a healthy attitude. The best way to do this is to find something that is unique for you – something that sparks the interest within. An author and civil rights leader Howard Thurman famously said, "Don't ask what the world needs. Ask, what makes you come alive, and go do it". Because what the world needs is people who have come alive.

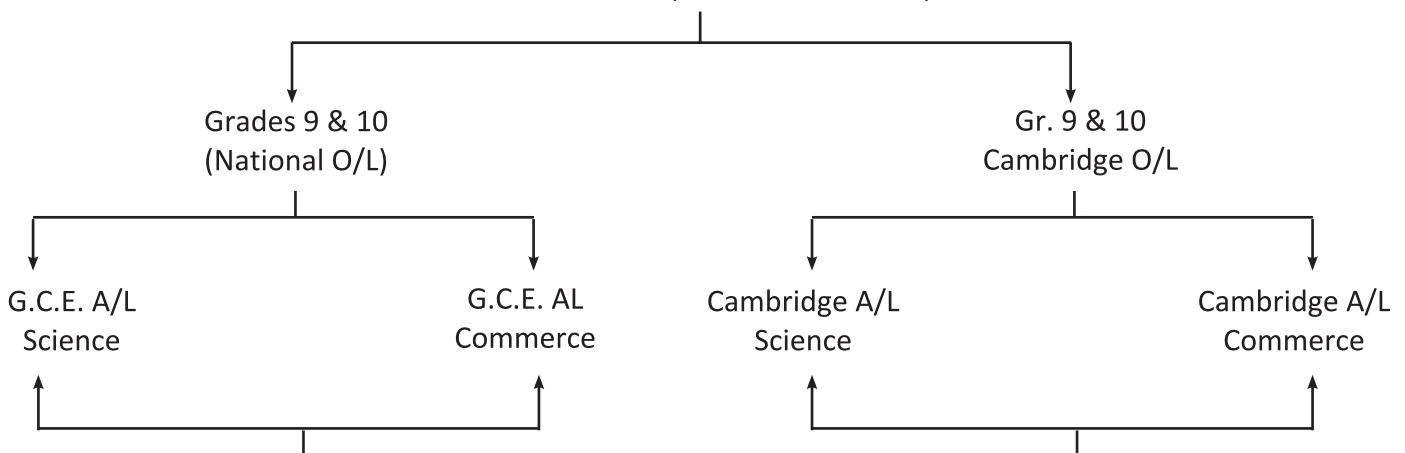


LETTERS ISSUED BY THE SCHOOL

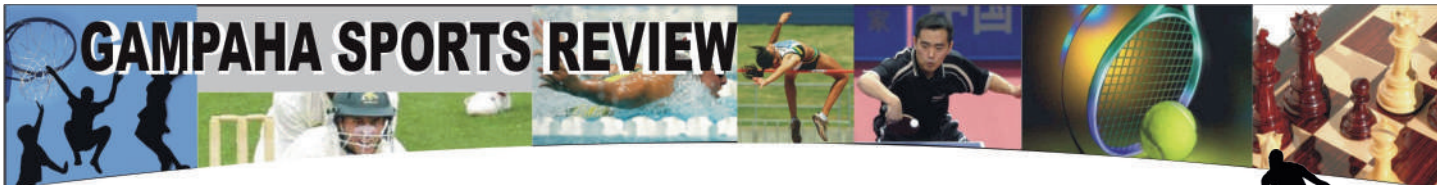
