DISCIPLINE AT HOME & SCHOOL

Maintaining good discipline among children at home and in school is a challenge faced by parents and teachers alike. Various strategies are used to achieve this. Among them, it is very important to consider the following:

The child must know what are the 'done things' and the 'not done things'. The child must know where to draw the line between these. The parents and the school must also agree about these, because if different signals go to the children from their parents and teachers, they will be confused.

Children must know the consequences and corrective actions of indiscipline and should accept the consequences if he / she falls into indiscipline. Once corrective actions are implemented it should be explained to the child why he / she should make a firm commitment not to repeat the mistake. The school authorities, teachers and the parents should accept the child who was corrected with a 'clean slate' and ask the child to put the past behind him / her and make a new start with a positive attitude.

SCHOOL FEES - ONLINE

School fees should be paid a week before the term commences. A surcharge will be levied if school fees are not paid after the 1st month of each term. Therefore, please pay your fees in time to avoid the surcharge. In case you have not received your paying-in voucher or have misplaced it, please collect a copy from the Accounts Department. If you wish to pay fees online, please follow the instructions below when making a payment.

Instructions for online payments ;

- Go to www.lyceum.lk.
- Click on the "Login" menu option, to access the login screen.
- Enter your username and the password; select the branch and click on the "Go" button to go to the parents' page of the Lyceum website.
- If you have not obtained the web access passwords, you may either
 - send an email to it_lg@lyceum.lk via the email address you have given to the Registrar or
 - visit the IT department (after school or on Parent-Teacher days) with the child's SRB and obtain the password.
- After you access the Parents' page of the website, click on the "Know About Your Child" link.
- In the new window, click on the "Payment Due" button in front of your child's name. (Click on the "Payment History" button to obtain a receipt after making the payment.)
- Enter your credit card details and follow the instructions.

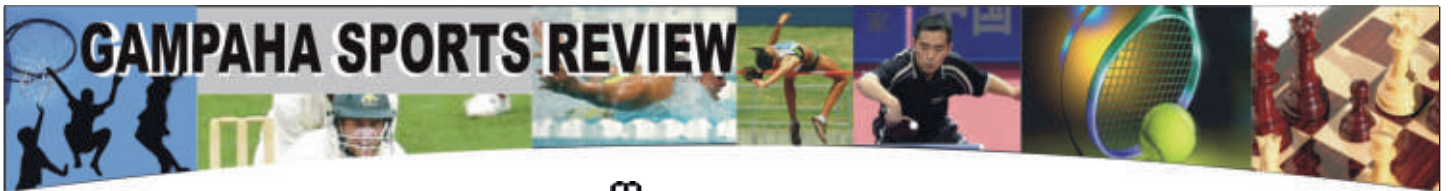
FIELD TRIPS

ATTENDANCE / ABSENCE

Students should be absent only due to illness or family emergencies. The school should be informed in writing by the parent of the reason for such absence on the first day when the student reports back to school. This should be written in the Student's Record Book. If a child is sick and is absent for three consecutive days or more, a medical certificate should be submitted. There should be a written entry in the S.R.B. duly signed by parent / guardian, with the same signature provided as specimen on page 4 of the S.R.B.

A student who suffers from an infectious disease should keep away from school until the full contagious period is over and should submit a medical certificate by an accepted medical practitioner. The medical certificate should be handed over to the school nurse before the student can be permitted to attend class sessions.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES - GR. 1 TO 12

To create and develop a healthy mind it is essential for a child to develop a healthy body. At Lyceum, we therefore, encourage our students to take part in sports and physical activities. With this in view we have planned extra curricular activities (ECA) for students of Grade 1 to 12.

- **Marks are given to children from Grade 6 to 12 at the end of each Semester for PT and the relevant Physical Sports participated in.**
- For students from Grades 1 to 5 swimming and PT are compulsory which are held during school time, and considered as subjects of the curricular.
- **From Gr. 6 upwards it is compulsory that every student participates in at least one Physical Sports activity to be eligible for marks for the selected activity at the semester examination.**
- **Please note that once you select a particular sport activity at the beginning of the first term (September) you cannot change the activity till the end of the year (August).**
- **Minimum attendance for Extra Curricular Activities Should be 50 % of the number of training days during the semester to qualify for the marks for the semester. Refer to the SHB - 1. Failure to do so will result in zero (0) marks for the activity. Attendance will be marked and it is the duty of the student to inform the TIC and get the attendance marked in the Student Record Book.**
- **Parents are strictly advised to collect their children soon after ECA is over.**
