## CONTACTING YOUR CHILD AFTER SCHOOL - Dialog SURAKSHA

Due to numerous requests made by parents about their children's safety, the school has approved the use of the 'Dialog Suraksha' device (more details of this device can be obtained from any Dialog Customer Care Service Center or online).

Parents need to send a request letter addressed to the Principal in order to obtain permission. Without this letter, any child found with the device, will have it confiscated from them. Please note that the Suraksha watch is not allowed and the restriction on using mobile phones still applies to all students.



- Outgoing & incoming calls are restricted to four parent approved numbers.
- No SMS / Internet access for the child.
- SOS Emergency button.
- Location tracker.
- Automatic notifications to the parent when the battery level reaches below 10% and the credit level is low.
- Device can be controlled only by the parent via SMS, #543# and Dialog Self Care Application.

## ELIGIBILITY FOR SRI LANKAN STATE UNIVERSITIES (NATIONAL A/L STUDENTS)

Please note that National A/L students should get a minimum of 35 marks for General English and 40 marks for General Knowledge in order to be eligible to enter the Sri Lankan state universities.

## LYCEUM CAPS

Caps, if worn with the uniform, should only be Lyceum caps. Other caps worn with the uniform will be confiscated. Also, caps should not be worn after entering the school premises.

## SCHOOL DROP OFF RULES

## AN APPEAL TO THE PARENTS

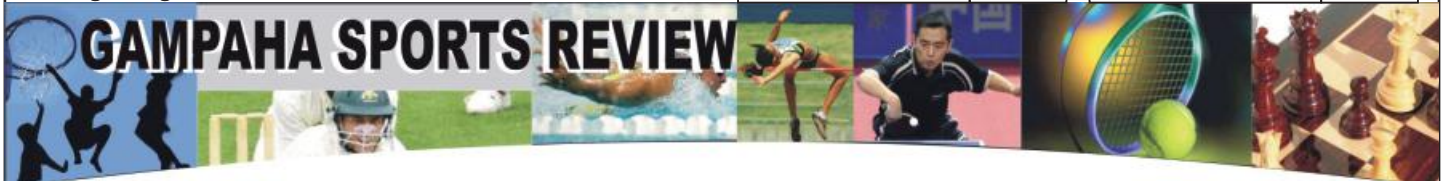

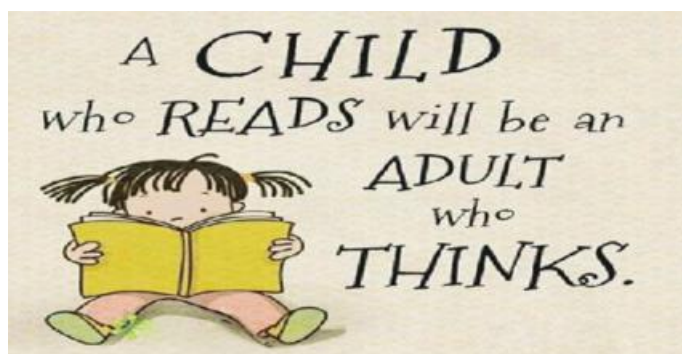
