Sir Don Baron Jayathilleke

Sir D. B. Jayatilaka presented the first budget of the state council, thus entering the record books as the first Sri Lankan to do so. During the budget presentation he stated that every child should receive education and that a government elected by the uneducated can be dangerous. In 1932 he was knighted by the king thus entering the record books again as the first Buddhist to be honoured. The Japanese raids over Colombo took place in 1942. The panic stricken residents of Colombo fled to rural areas. Unloading of ships at Colombo harbour came to a stand still resulting in a food scarcity. Sir D. B. Jayathilaka rose to the occasion, mustered 400 volunteers of Kelaniya electorate and unloaded the food ships. "The newspapers of the day reported "no leader had founded the hearts of people of Sri Lanka at so many points or embodied so authentically the very spirit of Sri Lanka as did Sir D. B. Jayatilaka.
